WISCONSIN DELLS SHINES IN TELEVISION SHOW

Wisconsin Dells is rolling out the red carpet, as the city takes center stage in a brand new episode of Discover Wisconsin Television.

The show, titled "Wilder than Ever – Wisconsin Dells," is scheduled for broadcast in 8 states throughout the Midwest on Saturday, March 27. Locally it will be broadcast at 10 a.m. on ComCast/Fox Sports Net, and at 5:00 p.m. on WKOW TV in Madison. (ABC.)

Many businesses and attractions are highlighted in the 30-minute program, including Noah's Ark, The Tommy Bartlett Show, the Original Wisconsin Ducks, Vertical Illusions Outdoor Adventures, Sundara Inn & Spa, Tourdot Winery, Tanger Outlet Mall, Glacier Canyon Lodge and Conference Center, Wild Rock Golf Club, the Woods Family Golf Course, Monk's Restaurant, Field's Premiere Steakhouse, Sarento's Italian Restaurant, the Wilderness Hotel & Golf Resort - including the new haunted house, Canopy Zip Line Tour, Fast Mollies, indoor and outdoor 3D mini-golf, Lost World Go-Carts and Mini-Carts, Dodge Em' City and Timberland Playhouse.

Stephanie Klett, host of Discover Wisconsin, was impressed with the Dells latest attractions. "In the late 80's and early 90's I worked my summers in Wisconsin Dells and thought it had a lot to offer then. Now, it is mind-blowing, and always growing and evolving every year."

Klett had the opportunity to try the new Canopy Zip Line Tour at the Wilderness Hotel. The new attraction features five "zips," with the longest run coming in at 914 feet with a top speed of 25 miles per hour. The zip line is 55 feet above the canyon.

"I know our viewers will respond to this new attraction," Klett said. "I was terrified to try it, but once you do it you wonder what you were ever afraid of. It is an awesome way to see the beauty of the Dells in a more adventurous way."

The episode was made possible by funding from the Wilderness Territory, Glacier Canyon Lodge at the Wilderness, and Wild Rock Golf Club.
