Glacier Canyon Conference Center
Adds New Team Building Option for Groups

WIS DELLS, Wis. – Glacier Canyon Conference Center at the Wilderness Resort recently unveiled a new team building opportunity, the Amazing Race, for groups of 36 or more hosting events at the resort.

The game is themed around a series of 4, 6 or 8 pit stops and 1 or 2 road blocks that each team has to complete. Teams are given a custom game map to help them navigate around the resort, and are required to get their Wilderness themed passport stamped after the completion of each pit stop. Each team also receives a Fast Pass that they can use at any pit stop to strategically gain a time advantage against the other teams as they race to the finish line.

According to Shannon Timmerman, director of sales, “The Amazing Wilderness Race is a fun team building activity that utilizes some of our great attractions on our 600 acre resort. It is a creative ways to encourage communication and build relationships while in a friendly and competitive atmosphere.”

In addition to this activity, the resort also owns two rooms escapes, an indoor ropes course, zip line, laser tag and championship golf all of which are perfect team building opportunities.

Meeting Space

Glacier Canyon Conference Center is a beautiful, rustic-themed, 55,561 square foot facility. The conference center can be divided up into many different configurations, and is capable of seating up to 1,200 guests for a fully-catered event. In addition, an outdoor patio and terrace overlooking stately pine trees can be used for memorable pre-function events.
