Consisting of 600+ acres, the Wilderness Resort located in Wisconsin Dells is home to three amazing waterpark properties: Wilderness Hotel, Wilderness on the Lake and Glacier Canyon Lodge. Together, these properties make up America's largest waterpark resort, offering 4 indoor and 4 outdoor waterparks totaling more than 500,000 square feet (that's 12 football fields) of water fun. Waterparks:

Indoor

- **Klondike Kavern**, occupying 65,000 square feet, this waterpark is home to the popular Hurricane thrill slide; Bonanza Bluff play feature; Mine Shaft Drop body slides; The Claim Jumper Challenge tube slides; a relaxing lazy river; indoor/outdoor basketball; and indoor/outdoor hot spa.
- **Wild WaterDome**, consisting of 70,000 square feet, this waterpark features a see-through roof that actually allows guests to tan indoor year-round so bring your sunscreen. It is also home to the America's largest indoor wave pool, the Great Wave; The Volcano Vortex and Paradise Falls water slides; Margarita's Swim-Up Bar; and Coral Cove, a zero-depth play 'n spray area.
- **Wild West**, spanning more than 70,000 square feet, this waterpark is home to the Black Hole thrill slide; Fantastic Voyage family raft ride; Warped Wagons dueling mat racers; Twisted Trails dueling tube rides; Ransack Ridge play area; YeeHaw's Watering Hole; an indoor/outdoor hot spa; and a zero-depth play 'n spray area.
- **Cubby's Cove**, measuring roughly 35,000 square feet, this waterpark offers a sports pool with basketball hoops; a lily-pad challenge; and a fun zero-depth spray feature.

Outdoor

- **New Frontier**, occupying over 95,000 square feet, this area includes Prospector's Creek lazy river; Gold Rush and Timber Falls tube slides; Golf Rush body slide; two banana slides; Toddler's Cover; Bear Foot Island Sprayground; 1 pool; Margarita's Swim up bar; Eagles Nest private cabana; and more!
- **Lake Wilderness**, measuring 40,000 square feet, this waterpark is home to a 13,000-square-foot Island Pool; Rafter's Rage tube slide; Rafter's Rage body slide; Lil' Chutes banana slides; a zero-depth area for toddlers; lap pool and water basketball; lily pad obstacle course; volleyball pool; hot spa and cabanas available for rent.
- **Lost World**, spanning 3.2 acres (139,392 square feet), this amazing waterpark is home to the Cosmic Drop and Lunar Loop extreme thrill slides; Halley's Comet Racers; the Lost World Adventure River; Crocodile Cove island pool; Fossil Falls play n' spray structure; Dino Mania water basketball, lily pad and sports slides; three outdoor hot spas and cabanas available for rent.
- **Cubby's Outdoor**, this waterpark is home to the Vanishing Edge Lagoon infinity pool as well as an indoor/outdoor hot spa, and fun zero-depth play area.

In total, there are 54 slides (29 Indoor and 25 Outdoor)

- 2 Extreme Slides, 2 Thrill Slides, 22 Kiddie Slides, 6 Banana Slides, 3 Raft Slides, 6 Racer Slides, 7 Tube Slides, and 6 Body Slides
- There are 3 lazy rivers, 2 lazy lakes, 1 wave pool, 4 kiddie pools with play structures, 6 toddler areas with toddler slides, 3 lily pad walks, 8 hot tubs, 4 activity pools and 2 swim up bars within all of these waterparks!
